FrontStreet Donates Use of Land to Gore Mountain

FrontStreet Mountain Development today announced that it has made a free lease of all of the Historic Ski Trails located on its property in the North Creek Ski Bowl to the Town of Johnsbury and Gore Mountain. In total, FrontStreet has now made available over 80 acres of skiable terrain for Gore Mountain Ski Area. The Historic Ski Trails are serviced by the Hudson Triple Chair ski lift located at the Ski Bowl just off Rte. 28 near the historic Village of North Creek, NY. These trails include the Ridge Runner Glades, Hudson Glades, Ski Bowl Glades and Little Gore Crossover.

Mac Crikelair, Project Manager for the Ski Bowl Village project stated: "We are delighted to make this additional property available for public skiing. This action will greatly expand the Ski Bowl portion of Gore Mountain and help bring skiers into the Village of North Creek. We are proud to be part of the public / private effort to expand Gore Mountain and the economy of North Creek."

The leased property is in addition to the over 40 acres of titled land FrontStreet had previously transferred to the Town of Johnsbury for the construction of the Hudson Triple chair lift and glades. This property was directly under the old T-bar ski lift that serviced the historic North Creek Ski Bowl for decades and is now the location of the Hudson Triple. The Hudson Triple Chair lift completed the interconnection between the Ski Bowl and Gore Mountain and paved the way for the reopening of the Historic Ski Bowl for public skiing, as part of the Gore Mountain Ski Area.
